

Instructions due to Coronavirus to our Employees, Customers and Business Associates

Due to latest developments related to the Corona virus COVID-19, MSK Group have taken the following actions to secure the proper functioning of the company and the safety of its employees, customers and business associates in all the Group's companies. As part of our risk management procedures, the following instruction has been issued:

The Group's staff have been instructed to transfer all meetings to a remote meeting and avoid travelling whenever that is possible.

If for some reason a remote meeting is not possible or a meeting can't be postponed, the following instruction is, without exception, to be followed:

Only visitors allowed to enter the Group's premises are those who have not during the last 14 day visited any of the high spread areas or travelled through any of those areas or been in contact with anyone who has been tested positive for Coronavirus.

Today, March 12th, the high-risk area includes Mainland China, Iran, South Korea and Italy. Local officials can also determine certain areas to high-risk areas you should avoid. These instructions also cover these areas so please follow the local official instructions. In Finland the high-risk areas also cover the skiing resorts in the Tyrol area in Austria and the state of North-Rhine Westphalia (Nordrhein-Westfalen) in Germany.
